*Minor changes are not substantive, e.g. typographical, grammatical and syntactical errors. If modifications are required, a committee (usually consisting of the thesis supervisor and a supervisory committee member) is struck to approve the revised thesis. Modifications must be completed by the student and approved by the committee within 3 months of the examination. Approval should be conveyed in writing to the graduate coordinator.
