Postdoctoral Position in Immunology

A postdoctoral position is available starting immediately in the laboratory of Dr. Clint Robbins at the Toronto General Research Institute, University Health Network. Dr. Robbins is a Canada Research Chair in Cardiovascular Immunology and the Peter Munk Chair in Complex Aortic Disease. The postdoctoral fellow will study the effects of cell proliferation on macrophage phenotype and function in health and disease.

Requirements: Candidates will have an MD and/or Ph.D. and a background in molecular and/or cellular immunology. Experience in immunobiology is preferred, but not necessary.
